FLOOD RELIEF



As the flood waters of Florence subside, the extent of the damage is finally beginning to be assessed. Clean-up and restoration will take a long time. In preparation for the work ahead, Mt. Pisgah will be joining with many other congregations throughout our district and synod to provide Disaster Response Flood Buckets. This project fills a 5-gallon bucket with all the supplies needed by workers for the clean-up effort.

Each bucket includes: Devotionals, Cleaning tips, Paper towels, Disposable rags, Glass cleaner, Cleansing powder, Liquid cleaner, Bleach (1-gallon size), Scrub brush, Two pairs of rubber gloves, Sponge(s), (Optional) broom and/or mop. The cost of materials for each bucket (including the bucket) is roughly \$30. Members of Bethlehem in Aiken, SC have volunteered to be the collection and distribution point for the Flood Buckets. They have also offered to assemble the buckets. This means that we can order the supplies and have them shipped directly to Aiken for packing. *If you would like to help the flood response efforts by contributing \$30 for a bucket or more for multiple buckets, please make your check payable to MPLC and put "Flood Relief" in the memo section.
