The Hunger Walk is Henderson County Hunger Coalition's only fundraiser. The Hunger Walk benefits local nonprofit organizations providing emergency assistance to hungry families.

You can make a five or ten-mile walk through Henderson County, or a family-friendly one to two-mile "fun walk" within Jackson Park. (Hunger Walk T-shirts will be given to the first 300 registered walkers). Drinking water and toilet facilities will be available at checkpoints. You can walk independently or with a group and collect pledges and donations for your walk, or you can sponsor a walker or group of walkers
